HOW TO REPLACE THE HELMET NECK PAD

This document is an additional information of your flight helmet instruction for use.

1 – How to remove the neck pad out of the helmet:

- Remove the two ear cups (photo 1 below on the left).

- Remove the neck pad **carefully** beginning from one extremity: a part is made of polystyren (photo 2 above on the right).

2 – How to place the neck pad into the helmet:

- Maintain the communication cables against the edge roll (photo 3 below on the left).

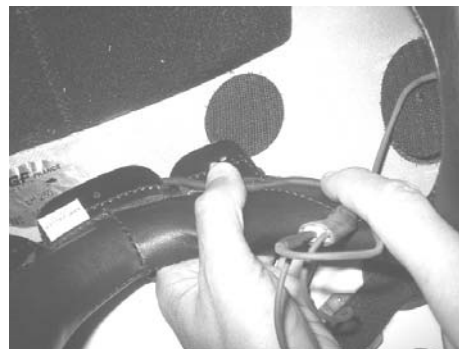

- Center and place the neck pad **carefully** close to the impact cap keeping the communication cables between the neck pad and the edge roll (photo 4 above on the right).

- Place the two ear cups.
