**REQUIRED MEASUREMENTS FOR
HELMET, MASK, AND LEG HOLSTER**

The diagrams illustrate the measurement points for helmet, mask, and leg holster.
 - **B***: Maximum distance between the corners of the mouth.
 - **Nasal Root**: Deepest impression of the nose line.
 - **C**: Distance from the nasal root to the supramentals.
 - **Supramentals**: Deepest impression between the lower lip and the chin.
 - **A**: Circumference of the head at the hatband line, above the ears and eyebrows.

Small Narrow	>2.13in/54.1mm	<3.375in/85.72mm
Medium Narrow	>1.96in/49.78mm	3.375-3.875in/85.72-98.42mm
Medium Wide	>2.46in/62.48mm	3.375-3.875in/85.72-98.42mm
Large Wide	>2.46in/62.48mm	>3.875in/98.42mm

> = greater than
< = lesser than

Nasal Root - deepest impression of the nose line

Supramentals - deepest impression between the lower lip and the chin

* To determine the “B” dimension, the subject’s facial muscles are relaxed and the jaws are closed. Measure the maximum distance between the corners of the mouth.
